- 6. Show Commission Report Marcia:

We made the 2013 show very exhibitor Friendly, but it was not financially profitable. There were 209 horses shown.

2014 will be A New Beginning! The show will be budgeted on a 230 horse show.

We need everyone to attend!

Sponsorships: \$1000, \$500, \$300, \$250 and \$100 & \$30 garlands

\$5000 will be added in prize money.

We will be presenting a trophy for Champion, large ribbons for Champion and Reserve, and Top 5 ribbons for remaining 3. There are plaques for Junior exhibitor classes .

Class fees will be \$70 each both main Ring and Sport Horse, Dressage will remain \$75, as there is a cost of tests.

There will not be a Pre Show, as we are trying to help support local clubs.

7. Treasurers Report: Karen.

The show had a minimal profit for 2013 with this being our major fundraiser for the Association we should consider this the first bad year for our budgeting purposes.

Battle Of the Breeds \$2000 is paid by R 17.

No Competitive rides for 2010-2013.

We have been successful in having the High Points fund themselves with sponsors.

The directory is continuing to be profitable.

The Select Stallion Auction has designated funds and will start paying out for performance classes in 2014.

2014 will be the last year of contract for Brandon. Will check other facilities.
